# 3-in-1 Double Crochet Woven Scarf

Beautiful scarves crocheted with double & single crochets, woven with decorative yarns.

Materials List - Per Scarf:

Yarn

1 skein Bernat® Baby Sport (100% acrylic, 12.3oz [350g], 1256yd [1148m]), Light/3, in color Baby Ecru (used approximately 3oz) (A)

1 skein Red Heart ® Boutique™ Magical™ (93% acrylic, 6% wool, 1% other fibers, 3.5oz [100g], 190yd [174m]), Medium/4, in color #1101 Crystal Ball (used approximately 2oz) (B)

Hooks & Notions Gauge Finished Measurement US H-8 (5mm) 4 dc = 1" (2.5cm)  $60" \times 5"$  (150cm x 12.5cm) (excluding tassels)

With A, chain 237 loosely because first row is worked through the back loop. (The pattern is worked in multiples of 4 + 3. If you wish to make the scarf longer or shorter add or delete 4 chains.)

Row 1: Working in back loop only, sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and in each ch across. (236 sc) Note: By working in the back loop, a 2-loop chain edge is left on the opposite side. This will match the completed edge along the other side of the scarf. No extra edging is needed. Be careful not to twist the base chain while working.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn. Skip 1<sup>st</sup> sc, \*dc in next sc; repeat \* across row. (236 dc)

Row 3: Ch3 (counts as first dc), turn. Skip 1<sup>st</sup> dc, \*dc in next dc; repeat \* across row.

Repeat Row 3 until piece measures 5" (12.5cm) or desired width.

Last Row: Ch 1, turn. Sc in each dc across row. Fasten off. Leave tail to be incorporated in tassels.

## **Brick Woven Design**

Row 1: With B weave 2 strands of yarn (or number to comfortably fill spaces) alternating over and under 2 dc posts.

Row 2: Alternate weaving under and over 2 dc posts (opposite of previous row).

Repeat Rows 1 & 2. Leave 8" (20cm) of yarn at each end to incorporate into tassels.

repeat nows 1 & 2. Leave 5 (20cm) of yarm at each end to incorporate





#### **Diagonal Woven Design**

Row 1: With B skip 3 dc and weave over and under 3 dc posts, continue alternating across row.

Row 2: Skip 2 dc and weave over and under 3 dc posts, continue alternating across row.

Row 3: Skip 1 dc and weave over and under 3 dc posts, continue alternating across row.

Row 4: Skip 3 dc and weave under and over 3 dc posts, continue alternating across row.

Row 5: Skip 2 dc and weave under and over 3 dc posts, continue alternating across row.

Row 6: Skip 1 dc and weave under and over 3 dc posts, continue alternating across row.

Repeat Rows 1-6. In correct design the lines will slant across the scarf. Leave 8" (20cm) of yarn at each end to incorporate into tassels.

### Tassel/Fringe

With B, add strands of yarn by loosely wrapping yarn around a DVD case or cardboard that is 8" (20cm) long. Cut along the bottom. Pick up four strands (or desired number) of decorative yarn or various mixture of yarns, loop them in half through first row on each scarf end, pull loop with hook from front to back, loop over all strands and tighten into a knot. After complete, slightly tug on each strand to tighten the knot. When finished, trim bottom of fringe to even edge.
